

PhD Student Fellowships in PIDE

Applications are invited from PhD students of PIDE for Student Fellowships in the project entitled “Climate Change, Agriculture, and Food Security in Pakistan: Adaptation Options and Strategies” sponsored by the International Development Research Centre (IDRC), Canada.

A stipend of Rs. 20000/month starting from June 01, 2013 for a maximum period of one and a half years (1½) will be provided. The Fellow shall be required to work at least 16 hours a week for the project in addition to thesis research.

Eligibility: The Scholars must have completed his/her course work, and qualified comprehensive exam. He/She must be willing to work on topic related to the project and under the supervision of the members of project team. Preference shall be given to the candidates having strong background in economic theory, econometrics and with a knowledge of agriculture and climate change related issues.

Applications are required on plain paper along with two page research proposal, detail CV and copies of academic transcripts (BS, MS/MPhil and PhD).

The last date for the submission of applications (addressed to Dr. Munir Ahmad, Project Leader) has been extended to 20th April 2013.
